### SANTA CLARITA VALLEY FAMILY YMCA DISTANCE LEARNING SUPPORT PROGRAM OPTIONS & FEE SCHEDULE: NEWHALL SCHOOL DISTRICT

**Welcome to the Santa Clarita Valley Family YMCA!** As the Newhall School District adapts its plans for the upcoming school year, you may be wondering how you will navigate the new school day structure while meeting the demands of work and home. The Santa Clarita Valley Family YMCA is here to support you!

We are pleased to extend a safe program option to you and your family, as we all work together through this pandemic. We are also honored to announce that this program will be partially subsidized by the Newhall School District. The Option A weekly subsidized rate is the standard weekly rate for the program. In addition, Option B and Option C provide a reduced weekly subsidized rate. Eligibility for Option B or Option C weekly subsidized rates are determined by a sliding scale, based on household income (proof of income to the YMCA is required). We are also offering an Option D for families contracted for services through CCRC, DCFS and other 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Providers.

Our programs will look a little different, compared to what you may be used to. Each day, we will support children in completing their distance learning. In addition, the program will offer STEAM activities, recreation and outdoor time, homework support and enrichment activities. We will offer all of this, while ensuring that physical distancing and all safety precautions are maintained. Daily, upon arrival, we will check the temperatures of all children and staff and conduct a daily wellness assessment. Throughout the day, children will have an opportunity to wash their hands, while staff disinfect and sanitize common surfaces. Children will remain in the same small group of 12 children or fewer, in the same room, with the same YMCA staff members. Staff will wear face coverings at all times and children will be encouraged to keep their face coverings on throughout the day. At night, the rooms will be deep cleaned, disinfected and sanitized, in preparation for the next day.

We know that the past few months have been challenging, to say the least. We hope to offer you and your family a little bit of relief to assist you in managing this upcoming school year. We look forward to seeing everyone at the Y again soon!

If the YMCA program is closed, the weekly fee will be prorated* for families on Option A (please see detailed fee schedule on the next page). Children enrolled in the ASES program at Wiley, will only attend the YMCA program until 2:30pm; at that time, the child will be transitioned to the Wiley ASES program. This program option is subsidized by the Newhall School District (NSD) to ensure that weekly fees are as affordable as possible. The program and the NSD subsidy will end on Friday, December 18; after which time, the program fees revert back to the unsubsidized price and families will have the option to enroll in future YMCA programs.         Option B       Operates Monday - Friday, from 7:00am - 6:00pm (or until 2:30pm, if enrolled in the ASES program at Wiley Canyon), from Thursday, August 13, 2020 to Friday, December 18, 2020 (see date details above). <ul> <li>Subsidy: This program is being provided by the YMCA in partnership with the NSD. The NSD has graciously provided a subsidy for every student in the district to ensure that all students have access to affordable full-day program, for working families. Spaces are limited and enrollment is on a first come, first serve bases. In order to ensure that the NSD can process your subsidized payment to the YMCA, families must adhere to the following:</li> <li>Once enrolled, children are expected to attend the program every day, except when sick/ill and when the program is closed. Attendance will be recorded each day and submitted to the district to certify the subsidy payment from the district to the YMCA. The unsubsidized price of the YMCA program ranges from \$190-\$280 per child (based on the number of children enrolled), per week. Your child's daily attendance shows the district that you appreciate the subsidy that they are providing and ensures that the YMCA is reimbursed by the district.</li> <li>Non-Attendance: There are no credits or refunds for non-attendance on program ranges from \$190-\$280 per child, per week (based on the number of children enrolled). Families are responsible for \$140, \$25, or \$10 per week, based on which option they qualify for, and the NSD reimburses the YMCA for the remaining balance. Failure to adhere to these policies and those listed in the YMCA Program Handbook, may result in the YMCA not receiving the subsidy reimbursement from the NSD. If this occurs, the parent, guardian or authorized representative will be responsible for the unpaid fees by the district, to the YMCA.</li> </ul>
