**Welcome to the San Pedro & Peninsula YMCA!** As local school districts have made the difficult decision to keep their campuses closed for in-person instruction this semester, you may be wondering how your child will receive the social-emotional support that they need, while you as a parent try to meet the demands of work and home. We know that social interactions, physical activity, exercise and outdoor time are just a few of the vital elements that children need in order to grow and thrive. The San Pedro & Peninsula YMCA, in partnership with the City of Rancho Palos Verdes Department of Parks & Recreation, is here to support you!

We are pleased to extend a safe after school recreational enrichment program option to you and your family, as we all work together through this pandemic.

Each day, children will have the opportunity to engage in fun and meaningful activities, all designed to ensure that physical distancing and all safety precautions are maintained. Activities include physical exercise, sports, games, arts & crafts, enrichment, STEAM, recreation, service learning, nature appreciation and so much more. Daily, upon arrival, our dedicated YMCA staff leaders will check your child's temperature and work with you to complete a quick intake health assessment. Throughout the day, children will have an opportunity to wash their hands, while staff disinfect and sanitize common surfaces. Children will remain in the same small group of up to 12 children or less, in the same area and with the same YMCA staff members, during the program. YMCA staff leaders and children will be required to wear a face covering. **This program is 100% outdoors at local Rancho Palos Verdes park sites.** Yes, our after school programs will look a little different, but one thing will always remain true: At Y programs, children gain a sense of **belonging, achieve** their goals and build strong **relationships**, all while having loads of fun!

We know that the past few months have been challenging, to say the least. We hope to offer you and your family a little bit of relief to assist you in managing this upcoming school year. We look forward to seeing everyone at the Y again soon!

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This program is provided continuously, each week, from Monday, September 14, 2020 to Friday, December 18, 2020.</li> <li>At the time of enrollment, an initial payment will be required for the first two weeks of the program:</li> <li>Beginning on Sunday, September 28, 2020, payments are made through a recurring electronic funds transfer (EFT) or automatic transfer service (ATS), using the credit card, debit account, checking or savings account provided by the parent, guardian or authorized representative at the time of enrollment, every other Sunday. Each payment covers 2 weeks of program, unless otherwise noted.</li> <li>All cancellations must be requested, in writing, 15 days prior to your next billing date. Without such notice, ATS/EFT draft billing will continue on a recurring schedule, as referenced in the aforementioned bullet (see detailed fee schedule on the next page).</li> <li>All programs run Monday-Friday, 3:00pm-6:00pm, unless otherwise noted. All program fees are standard and are not prorated for shortened weeks of program.</li> <li>This program only operates on the days when school is normally in session. This program will be closed on all holidays, school breaks and pupil-free days.</li> <li><b>This program will take place 100% outdoors</b>, at the community parks listed below. The YMCA reserves the right to combine park locations, if the enrollment at one or more park location is below the minimum enrollment required.</li> <li>This program will not operate on days with inclement weather (rain/storm), where the YMCA has determined that it is unsafe to operate outdoors. The YMCA will not provide any credits or refunds due to a naturally occurring inclement weather closure. Tents and canopies will be set up at each program location, to provide shade during hot days. Children should bring sunscreen and a water bottle each day, wear a hat for shade, and, if possible, bring a handheld mister.</li> <li><b>Non-Attendance:</b> There are no credits or refunds for non-attendance on program days of operation.</li> <li>The YMCA reserves the right to cancel this program at any time, due to low enrollment or other factors.</li> <li>For a complete list of our program policies, please see the most recent edition of our <b>Program Handbook</b>.</li> <li>All enrollees must complete an <b>Enrollment Packet</b> prior to the child's first day of program.</li> </ul>
