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## SAN PEDRO & PENINSULA YMCA DISTANCE LEARNING AFTER SCHOOL RECREATIONAL ENRICHMENT PROGRAM OPTIONS & FEE SCHEDULE (IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE CITY OF RANCHO PALOS VERDES DEPARTMENT OF PARKS & REC)

**Welcome to the San Pedro & Peninsula YMCA!** As local school districts have made the difficult decision to keep their campuses closed for in-person instruction this semester, you may be wondering how your child will receive the social-emotional support that they need, while you as a parent try to meet the demands of work and home. We know that social interactions, physical activity, exercise and outdoor time are just a few of the vital elements that children need in order to grow and thrive. The San Pedro & Peninsula YMCA, in partnership with the City of Rancho Palos Verdes Department of Parks & Recreation, is here to support you! We are pleased to extend a safe after school recreational enrichment program option to you and your family, as we all work together through this pandemic.

Each day, children will the opportunity to engage in fun and meaningful activities, all designed to ensure that physical distancing and all safety precautions are maintained. Activities include physical exercise, sports, games, arts & crafts, enrichment, STEAM, recreation, service learning, nature appreciation and so much more. Daily, upon arrival, our dedicated YMCA staff leaders will check your child's temperature and work with you to complete a quick intake health assessment. Throughout the day, children will have an opportunity to wash their hands, while staff disinfect and sanitize common surfaces. Children will remain in the same small group of up to 12 children or fewer, in the same area and with the same YMCA staff members, during the program. YMCA staff leaders and children will be required to wear a face covering. **This program is 100% outdoors at local Rancho Palos Verdes park sites.** Our after school programs will look a little different, but one thing will always remain true: At Y programs, children gain a sense of **belonging, achieve** their goals and build strong **relationships**, all while having loads of fun!

We know that the past few months have been challenging, to say the least. We hope to offer you and your family a little bit of relief to assist you in managing this upcoming school year. We look forward to seeing everyone at the Y again soon!

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### Fee Schedule

- This program is provided continuously, each week, from Monday, September 14, 2020 to Friday, December 18, 2020.
- At the time of online registration, an initial payment for the child's first two weekly session of the program will be required.
- Once enrolled and after the initial payment is made, **the system will then configure a customized automatic payment plan, based on the child's enrollment start date.** Future payments are made in two-week intervals through a recurring electronic funds transfer (EFT) or automatic transfer service (ATS), using the credit card or debit account provided by the payer at the time of enrollment. Each recurring payment is charged for and covers two weekly sessions of program. **Please see "How the Payment Plan Works" on the next page.**
- All cancellations must be requested, in writing, 15 days prior to your next billing date. Without such notice, ATS/EFT draft billing will continue on a recurring schedule, as referenced in the aforementioned bullet (see detailed fee schedule on the next page).
- All programs run 5 days per week, Monday-Friday, unless otherwise noted. All programs run from 2:30pm-5:30pm, unless otherwise noted. Program fees are weekly and at a set rate, regardless of how many days the program runs within each week; weekly program fees are not adjusted and are not prorated based on the child's attendance, program days of operation during the week, inclement weather closings, holidays, program days of non-operation and/or the child's arrival/departure time to the program.
- This program only operates on the days when school is normally in session. This program will be closed on all holidays, school breaks and pupil-free days.
- This program will take place 100% outdoors**, at the community parks listed below.
- This program will not operate on days with inclement weather (rain/storm/poor or hazardous air quality), where the YMCA has determined that it is unsafe to operate outdoors. The YMCA will not provide any credits or refunds due to a naturally occurring inclement weather closure. Tents and canopies will be set up at each program location, to provide shade during hot days. Children should bring sunscreen and a water bottle each day, wear a hat for shade, and, if possible, bring a handheld mister.
- Non-Attendance:** There are no credits or refunds for non-attendance on program days of operation.
- The YMCA reserves the right to cancel this program at any time, due to low enrollment or other factors. If program enrollment is low at multiple sites, the YMCA reserves the right to combine/merge program sites.
- For a complete list of our program policies, please see the most recent edition of our **Program Handbook**.
- All enrollees must complete an **Enrollment Packet** prior to the child's first day of program.
- Should the local or partnering school district modify or alter their distance learning program and/or resume school, on-campus or in a hybrid model, the YMCA reserve the right to change, modify, adjust, cancel, reclassify, or restructure its program options and rates.

- The program fees listed below are weekly and at a set rate, regardless of how many days the program runs within each week; weekly program fees are not adjusted and are not prorated based on the child's attendance, program days of operation during the week, inclement weather closings, holidays, program days of non-operation and/or the child's arrival/departure time to the program.
- At the time of online registration, an initial payment for the child's first two weekly sessions of the program will be required.
- If the program is already in session and the child's program start date is mid-week, the weekly program does not prorate.
- Once enrolled and after the initial payment is made, the online system will configure a customized automatic payment plan scheduled for every other week, on every other Sunday. Future payments are made in **two-week intervals** through a recurring electronic funds transfer (EFT) or automatic transfer service (ATS), using the credit card or debit account provided by the payer at the time of enrollment. Each recurring payment is charged for and covers two weekly sessions of program.
